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OVERVIEW

Tobacco Treatment Specialists (TTS's) are health care professionals who possess the skills, knowledge, and training to provide effective, evidence-based interventions for tobacco dependence across a range of treatment intensities, in varying contexts, treatment modalities, and with different tobacco using populations.

The **MSK 4-day, Tobacco Treatment Specialist Live Virtual Training Program** is designed to train multidisciplinary clinicians who work in various healthcare and community settings including primary care, behavioral health, addictions and rehabilitation settings, public housing, oncology settings, specialty medical care such as (e.g. pulmonary medicine, cardiology, oncology), and worksite wellness settings.

We do ask that all registered attendees have access to a computer with a Webcam as this training is highly interactive. This live virtual course will be delivered using Zoom.
